The heart drives everything:

• Proverbs 4:23; 1 Kings 11:1-10

Matt. 12:34; 13:14-15 – What's the order?

• Ephesians 4:17-18 – What's the order?

• The passion-driven life

Problem: Exodus 4:21; 7:3, 13-14, 22; 8:15,32; Zech. 7:12; Matt. 15:8-9, 18-19¹

The call: Deut. 10:12-16; Jer. 4:4; Ezek. 18:31

The solution: Deut. 30:6; Jer. 31:33; Ezek. 11:19; 36:26

- 4. And the key prayer: Luke 24:45; Eph. 1:17-22; 3:14-19
- 5. And the joy of the Lord is your strength: Nehemiah 8:10
